This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child's family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child's death; whether the child or the child's family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child's death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child's death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child's household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child's siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS' review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS' assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

On 11/27/2013, a report was made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment with allegations of DOA/Fatality and Inadequate Guardianship on behalf of a five-month-old female subject child, against her mother and father. The report alleged the subject child was found in her crib unresponsive and cold to the touch approximately one hour after being put down for a nap. Emergency Medical Services (EMS) was called and upon arrival found the subject child in cardiac arrest. The subject child was pronounced dead at a local hospital. A stain that was pinkish-red in color was observed on the child's bedding and was believed to have been blood from the child's mouth. The cause of death was unknown.

Executive Summary

A report was made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment on 11/27/2013, which alleged DOA/Fatality and Inadequate Guardianship against the mother and father on behalf of a five-month-old female subject child. The subject was found unresponsive by the child's father. Emergency Medical Services were called to the home, and resuscitation efforts were made, but the child was pronounced dead at the hospital.

The Rockland County Department of Social Services (RDSS) investigated. The caseworker made multiple visits to the case address to ensure the safety of the surviving siblings and to assess if the family needed any services. The caseworker offered bereavement counseling and preventive services, but the family was engaged with bereavement counseling with a community provider and declined additional RDSS involvement. There were no concerns noted by the caseworker regarding the safety and well-being of the surviving siblings. The agency utilized appropriate staff fluent in the family's primary language, when available.

Given the family's religious practices, a partial (external) autopsy was completed. The preliminary autopsy did not find any signs of trauma or abuse. The allegations against both parents were unfounded on 1/15/2014, as the final cause of death was undetermined and there was no evidence the parents contributed to the death in any way. The agency met all regulatory standards while completing the investigation.

LDSS Response

A report was made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment on 11/27/2013, which alleged DOA/Fatality, and Inadequate Guardianship, against the mother and father on behalf of the five-month-old female subject child. Due to the family's religious beliefs, an partial (external) autopsy was conducted by the Rockland County Medical Examiner, and no outward signs of abuse were observed. The final autopsy report was unavailable at the time this report was written.

Rockland County Department of Social Services (RCDSS) conducted an investigation into the allegations. Appropriate collateral contacts were made regarding the subject child's medical history and to confirm details of events leading up to the child's death. Collateral contacts were made regarding the surviving siblings, including contacting school, day care, and medical providers. The caseworker did not note any concerns regarding the surviving siblings. The case was well documented, detailed and all assessments were appropriate and timely. Appropriate service referrals were offered to the mother; however, she declined and stated the family was receiving bereavement counseling within their own community.

On 1/15/2014, RCDSS made the determination to unsubstantiate all allegations against the mother and father on behalf of the subject child. The basis for determination was the final cause of death was undetermined, and the external autopsy did not reveal any outward signs of abuse. There was no evidence either parent contributed to the child's death. The determination was made within the required sixty-day mandate.

The Office of Children and Family Services reviewed the RCDSS CPS case record and found the investigation complied with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.
